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**INVESTIGATION:**

Reporting Detective (R/D) received assignment of a weapons discharge investigation on 13 August 2017 at approximately 0530 hours. Det. French #20674 and Det. DOHERTY# 20437 were assigned by first watch, HGS, Coordinator Sgt. Lambert #2415 to respond, to the area of Chelsea Pl. and Hermosa Av. to investigate a weapons discharge incident by a member of the Chicago Police Department. In furtherance of this investigation detectives proceeded to the crime scene.

Upon arrival to the crime scene, R/Ds observed the 22nd District officers erecting crime scene tape to ensure the protection of scene to prevent vehicle, pedestrian and traffic from destroying any and all evidentiary items. The north end of the crime scene consisted of approximately 10927 S. Hermosa proceeding south to approximately 11200 S. Monterey Ave. The east and west boundaries were Chelsea Pl. on the east and Wood St. on the west. Evidence was recovered in two locations within the crime scene. It should be noted the crime scene is outdoors with artificial lighting emanating from the overhead street lights. Hermosa Av. is a two-way street with traffic that travels north and south. Adjacent to the street is the parkway and sidewalks on both the east and west side of the street. The north area is residential and is comprised of single-family homes.

The south area of the crime scene was the 11100 block of S. Hermosa Av. Hermosa Av. is a single lane avenue which ends with a cul-de-sac at approximately 11150 south on Hermosa. On the west side of the street is a single, multi-unit, residence located at 11100 S. Hermosa Av. To the south of this residence is a parking lot and the Morgan Park High School tennis courts. To the south of the tennis courts is a circular drive which leads to an alley way to the west. On the east side of the street is a sidewalk and the Morgan Park High School soccer field. This is an open outdoor area with artificial lighting emanating from the overhead street lights from Morgan Park High School. The "Quad" consists of a side walk that covers from the Hermosa Ave. cul-de-sac to Monterey Ave. and has a circular pathway in the middle. To the west of this sidewalk are three paved lots that are used as parking lots for Morgan Park High School. The east side of the side walk is Morgan Park High School which consists of three large buildings connected with corridors and breeze ways. R/Ds observed crime scene tape erected and the crime scene was totally enclosed.

As R/Ds were assessing the crime scene, Sgt. MUHAMMAD approached R/Ds. At this time R/Ds asked MUHAMMAD what happened. MUHAMMAD related the following that should be considered in summation and not a verbatim statement. MUHAMMAD related he was in his vehicle on his way home and observed a guy in the bushes. MUHAMMAD engage the guy. The guy started running. At this point MUHAMMAD stopped the interview to wait to tell everyone at once the account of the story.

R/Ds continued to canvass the area. R/Ds were approached by Sgt. FERNANDEZ #1569, Beat 2210R, who related at approximately 10957 S. Hermosa a black cell phone was recovered by citizen [REDACTED]

R/Ds continued to canvass the area which revealed a single fired casing at approximately 10958 S. Hermosa. A second shell casing was discovered at approximately at 11211 S. Hermosa.

At this time, R/Ds continued the canvass for possible witnesses. A separate Canvass Supplemental Report should be read in conjunction with this report.

**INTERVIEWS:**

All interviews are considered in summation and not verbatim statements.

P.O. WILLIAMS #14376

WILLIAMS while on an unrelated incident observed [REDACTED] running through the neighborhood north bound on Hermosa Av. with a red and black striped shirt. WILLIAMS observed [REDACTED] running with his right hand at his side at approximately 0454 hours. WILLIAMS was assigned a radio assignment and was unable to conduct a field investigation.

P.O. HOBBS #8013

HOBBS while on an unrelated incident related he observed [REDACTED] running through the neighborhood on Hermosa Av. however, received radio assignment from dispatch. HOBBS did not engage [REDACTED] for a field interview. HOBBS related hearing the radio call of a person shot. After completing the radio assignment, HOBBS relayed he was assigned to assist with crime scene protection at Chelsea Pl. and Hermosa Av.

Sgt. Khalil MUHAMMAD #960

The following interview took place on the scene and should not be considered a verbatim statement only a summation. MUHAMMAD related he was traveling in his vehicle west bound on Chelsea Pl. He turned right which is north bound on Hermosa Av. MUHAMMAD observed a white Honda running on the street. Sgt. MUHAMMAD drove past the alley on the west side of the street (10940 S. Hermosa Av.) and saw a M/1, now known as [REDACTED] on the west side of the street at about 10914 S. Hermosa Av.

MUHAMMAD related he approached [REDACTED] and announced his office at this time [REDACTED] began to flee on foot south bound on Hermosa Av. Sgt. MUHAMMAD related he drove his vehicle about 30 feet and made a U-turn. Sgt. MUHAMMAD then located [REDACTED] running towards the white Honda, which was parked [REDACTED] then ran onto the sidewalk.

MUHAMMAD related he announced his office by stating "Yo police," "Let me see your hands." [REDACTED] then turned and faced MUHAMMAD while reaching towards his back. [REDACTED] then produced his hands. [REDACTED] had a black object in his hand MUHAMMAD and at that time MUHAMMAD fired two shots at approximately 10947 S. Hermosa Av. [REDACTED] then throws an object into the air after the shots are fired.

[REDACTED] then runs south bound on Hermosa Av. Sgt. MUHAMMAD exited his vehicle and returned to his vehicle, then followed [REDACTED] south bound on Hermosa Av. to the rear of Morgan Park High School.

MUHAMMAD related he proceeded with caution while following [REDACTED] MUHAMMAD then exited his vehicle, fearing he may be trapped in the vehicle. MUHAMMAD related he yelled, "Police, Police, Police get on the ground." [REDACTED] complied with MUHAMMAD'S verbal directions and [REDACTED] got on the ground. MUHAMMAD detained [REDACTED] behind Morgan Park High School. MUHAMMAD called 911 for assistance and medical attention. MUHAMMAD placed an additional call the 005th District desk for notification.

The mobile Crime Lab arrived to process the crime scene for any and all items of evidentiary value. Beat 5830, Sgt. HARB #2055, Beat 5822, ET. COCO #5238, ET. FOSTER #14410, and Beat 5824, ET. MANGUERRA #14098 arrive and videotaped and photographed the scene. Any and all items of

evidentiary value were recovered and submitted to the Crime Lab for examination. For specific details please refer to the Crime Scene Processing Reports.

DOHERTY #20437, and FOP Representative FARRELL, MUHAMMAD service weapon, one holster, one Glock 9MM magazine with 13 head stamp 9mm Luger +P win (live rounds) and one head stamp 9mm Luger +P win round in the chamber were recovered and inventoried by the Crime Lab.

R/D conducted an additional interview with MUHAMMAD at Area South Detective Division at which time essentially related the same accounts as previously given.

R/Ds conferred with Lt. MUHAMMAD # 313 of Area South, HGS, Sgt. LAMBERT #2415, and Sgt. PELLEGRINI # 1932 for direction in the investigation.

It should be noted that members of the Chicago Police Department Command Staff and COPA personnel arrived at the Area South Detectives Division as the investigation continued.

It should be noted camera footage was requested from Chicago Pubic Schools and OEMC Recorded Voice Transmission for event 16660 to be archived.

Upon contact with the Area South Detective Division Office, R/Ds were informed that Log# 1086385 and U# 17-016 were obtained for this incident.

This investigation was reviewed by Area South Detective Division Personnel and Command Personnel of the Chicago Police Department. Sgt. MUHAMMAD could not articulate to R/D criminal acts committed by ██████████ This investigation is ongoing and continues.

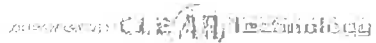

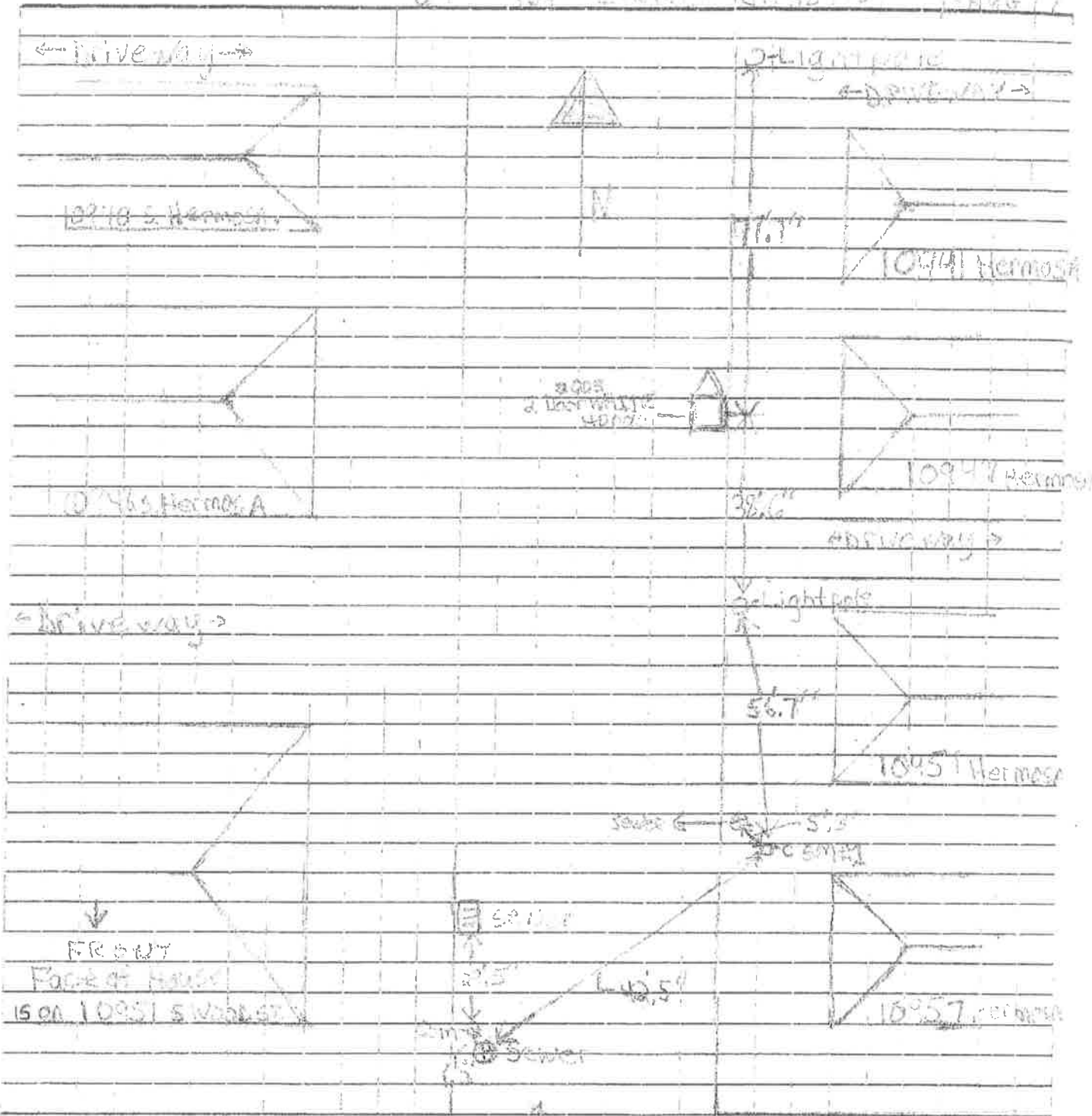

1. Are you injured? If so, what are your injuries?
2. Is anyone else injured? If so, what are their injuries and where are they located?
3. Did you fire your firearm? If so, where were you located when you fired and approximately how many rounds?
4. Did any subject fire a firearm? If so, in what direction and approximately how many rounds?
5. Are any subjects at-large? If so:
  - a. How many subjects are wanted?
  - b. What are their descriptions (including any vehicle information) and their method of flight?
  - c. What was their direction of travel?
  - d. How long ago did they flee?
  - e. For what crimes are they wanted?
  - f. Were they armed? If so, what type of weapon(s) did you observe?
6. Do you know of any evidence? If so, what is the evidence and where is it located?
7. Do you know of any witnesses? If so, where are the witnesses located?
8. Is there anything else that I need to know to ensure public safety, preserve evidence, or secure the incident scene?
