**Re: Chicago Justice Project Request for Information**

Dear Ms. Yeddanapudi:

We write further to our conversation with regard Chicago Justice Project ("CJP") and its request for updates to information provided in resolution of the litigation captioned *Chicago Justice Project v. Cook County State's Attorney's Office*, Case No. 15 CH 18147 (the "Litigation").

Based on our conversation, I understand that the Cook County State's Attorney's Office will provide to CJP the data set it previously provided in resolution of the Litigation, except that the newly provided data will also include all data to the current date. We understand that CCSAO is unable to simply provide an updated data set including data from the last production to the current date. Please confirm that the foregoing is accurate.

If so, CJP will agree to accept the entire data set current to the date CCSAO runs its query. CJP requests that the following data formatting be followed:

- The data must be exported in a delineated format.
- Any string or text field in the CSV files be wrapped in double quotes, so as to avoid parsing issues. Doing so is necessary to enable a data parser to recognize an entry as a single field instead of three separate fields. For example:
  - **Incorrect:** 200 N Lake Street, Chicago, IL
  - **Correct:** "200 N Lake Street, Chicago, IL"
- Any text fields that already have double quotes should themselves be closed with double quotes as follows. For example:

- Incorrect: Chicago “The Windy City”
- Correct: “Chicago ““The Windy City””””
- For any additional outlier cases, including newlines and other special characters, please refer to the instructions for Common Format and MIME Type for Comma-Separated Values (CSV) Files available at <https://tools.ietf.org/html/rfc4180>.

Please let us know if you have any questions. If not, we ask that you confirm that the CCASO will run the data set with parameters set forth above, and please provide us with an approximate date when this data will be available. CJP reserves all rights.
